The purpose of the section is to highlight the current applicable UMCP Design Standards for soil treatment as required by the Maryland Department of the Environment (MDE).

- U.S. Army Corps of Engineers (COE) regulations and guidelines

**General Requirements:**

- The identification of regulated wetlands and areas within the 100 year floodplain areas within the site limits is required in accordance with Maryland Department of the Environment (MDE) or U.S. Army Corps of Engineers (COE) regulations and guidelines.
- The identification of such areas shall be the first priority of the site design and the existence of these areas shall be brought to the immediate attention of the University.
- Any disturbance within a non-tidal wetland or its buffer is subject to regulation as is construction within the 100-year floodplain.
- Approval from the appropriate reviewing agency(s) is necessary for any such disturbance or construction.
